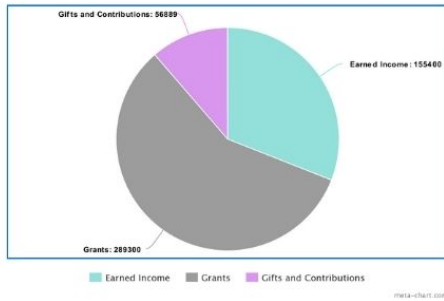
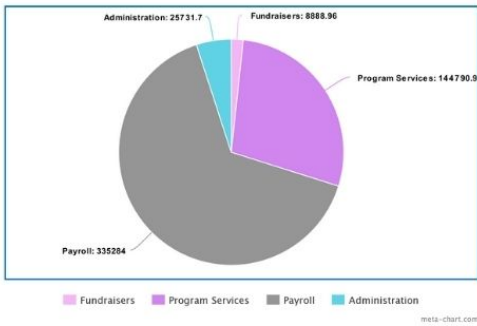

Affordable, professional dance classes for children and young people

BalletRox Dance! offers affordable, professional dance classes to children and young people in grades K-12 during the school year. Classes are open to ages 4 to 18 for all levels (beginning to advanced). We offer a variety of dance forms, including tap, jazz, modern, Afro-Caribbean, Afro-Fusion, Brazilian, step, hip-hop, and creative movement. Our dance classes are taught by professional and passionate BalletRox instructors, some of which also teach in the BalletRox/Boston Public Schools Dance Program. In addition to our Spontaneous location, this year, we expanded our programming to the Vine Street Community Center in Roxbury, MA.



BalletRox programs currently focus on education through in-school and after-school programs. The organization continues to grow and is regarded as a treasured community resource, working closely with Boston Public Schools (BPS) and the greater Boston community in an effort to help integrate arts, specifically dance, into our schools and the lives of underserved youth.



BalletRox recently reinstated its membership with the National Honors Society for Dance Arts. NHSDA's mission is to recognize outstanding artistic merit, leadership, and academic achievement in students studying dance in public and private schools in K-12 education, dance studios, cultural/community centers, performing arts organizations, and post-secondary education.
