

#### 2024 Studio Program

In Fiscal Year 2024, BalletRox's studio program continued to serve children and youth, ages 2.5 to 18, from underserved communities across Boston. The program offered a wide range of dance classes, including Creative Movement, ballet, tap, hip hop, and soca, in its studio spaces in Jamaica Plain and Roxbury. The Studio Program has experienced a 20% increase in enrollment compared to the previous year, with full scholarships awarded to 40% of participating families.

#### **BPS Program**

Building on the success of previous year programs, BalletRox continued its partnerships with P.A. Shaw and Conley Elementary Schools and renewed its collaboration with Mather Elementary School. These efforts reaffirm the organization's commitment to delivering impactful dance programs



#### **External Partners Program**

In Fiscal Year 2024, BalletRox expanded its external partner program by establishing new collaborations with schools such as the Healey School in Somerville and St. John School in the North End. We also continued its partnership with Mission Grammar School, with plans for additional collaborations anticipated in the coming year.
